Education Committee

Early childhood and teacher training are two crucial issues facing Jamaica's education system. Hence, JAMPACT's Education Committee has gravitated towards these two areas. Our goals are twofold: to provide financial support and maintain strong ties with institutions and persons representative of these two areas. This includes, among other things, adopting basic schools in Jamaica and building a scholarship fund for students at various teachers colleges.

Communications Committee
